- Find out what the terms GROSS MOTOR SKILLS and FINE MOTOR SKILLS mean and write a definition in your own words.
- Give an example of a gross motor skills and a fine motor skill for each of the development ages below:
New-born / 1 month / 6 months / 9 – 10 months / 12 – 13 months / 18 months / 2 years
- Imagine if a Martian from outer space came down and landed in your front room. They are trying to understand how there can be two different types of human i.e. male and female and why they look so different. Using your understanding of how gender is determined at fertilisation and the changes that occur during puberty to boys and girls, explain as clearly as you can to help them in their quest.

 3. When did the condition first start to affect him?
