Communication

Sharing information with others and explaining ideas clearly

Patience

Being able to cope with delays without becoming annoyed

Community

Showing you belong to Wyvern and take part in events

Problem solving

The ability to find a solution to a complex situation or challenge.

Honesty

Being truthful, even if it makes you feel uncomfortable.

Self-motivated

Doing things for yourself, without being told by others.

Leadership

Supporting, encouraging and motivating others to achieve a

Teamwork

Working with others to achieve a common goal

Listening skills

Actively listening so you understand what others are saying.

Time management

Meeting deadlines and making the best of the time that you have.
