Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers,

First, can I express my thanks and gratitude for your attendance at our recent parent evening event. I hope that both pupils and parents/carers found this evening useful to connect and engage with subject teachers.

I wanted to inform you of upcoming events that are occurring in preparation for the examinations that will commence in the summer.

February half term

During the half term, there will be two sessions running to support revision for both English and Maths. The sessions will run **on Monday 20th February 2023 for English** and **Thursday 23rd February 2023 for Maths**. Both sessions will be facilitated by the respective subject specialists. Sessions will run from 10.00am to 1.00pm. Pupils should arrive with their own lunch as there will no catering staff in. Pupils can also arrive in their own clothes.

Mock examination cycle

The second cycle of mock exams will commence on the first day of the new term in February (Monday 27th February 2023, 9.00am). The timetable for exams is attached at the end of this letter. It is vital that pupils are on time for each exam, with morning exams starting at 9.00am and afternoon exams starting at 12.45pm. If, for whatever reason, pupils are absent on the day of an exam that they were due to sit an exam, they will be entered into the catch up sessions which are distributed across the two weeks.

To reward the hard work of our pupils, we are once again running a rewards trip at the conclusion of the examination cycle. More details about this will follow. However, in order to qualify for this, all pupils must have sat their full exams, with professional conduct. This process will mirror the summer examination cycles and be conducted in the same manner.

To further support our existing package of revision, the period 6 timetable will be amended to provide support the day before an exam. Breakfast sessions will also run daily, with breakfast provided.

Additional information

During our Vision and Values sessions, all pupils have been attending academic intervention to booster their skills in both English and Maths. These sessions, alongside the existing breakfast and period 6 sessions, contribute to our revision offer that is currently available at Wyvern Academy. The Study Zone is now open for pupils to attend Monday to Thursday, 3.00pm – 5.00pm to complete independent revision, whilst also having access to computer facilities and subject specific material.
