Dear Parent/Carer,

End of Summer Term/ Beginning of Autumn Term - Arrangements

3. School Uniform

As we enter a new academic year, our expectations for school uniform remain consistently high. Further information relating to uniform can be found on our <u>website</u>, along with our <u>uniform policy</u>. Please carefully familiarise yourself with this information before buying uniform. Incorrect uniform will be challenged and addressed upon entrance to school. Students who are unable to adhere to the uniform policy will be provided with appropriate uniform to ensure the high standards we expect of our Professional Learners.

Our uniform expectations are below:

- Black straight leg school trousers which reach to below the ankle (no jeans or leggings) OR
- Black, knee-length, pleated school skirt (not in jersey).
- Shirt, Plain white with proper collar (Polo Shirts are not permitted).
- Black tights or knee-length socks in black or white.
- Tie Wyvern stripe available from the school (1 tie given free to each new student in Year 7).
- Blazer, black with school logo.

4. Climate for Learning

At Wyvern Academy, we are committed to providing a climate for learning that is disruption free, concentrating on 'excellence in all that we do' and ensuring that all of our students receive ambitious and challenging Teaching and Learning, 'day-in, day-out'. External visitors frequently comment on the calm, orderly environment that the academy provides, with friendly, courteous and polite students who are professional learners.

We are passionate in our quest to continue to improve our climate for learning and minimise distractions. The use of mobile phones continues to be not permitted when on the school premises. Mobile phones will be permitted to be carried by students, but must be turned off and in their school bag. If a student is seen accessing a mobile phone on the school site, they will be politely asked by a member of staff to turn it off and put the phone in their bag. Students who repeatedly use their mobile phones will have their mobile phone confiscated. This will be held in a secure location. A Parent or Carer will be contacted to collect the mobile phone at the end of the day, this will not be returned back to the student.

As Parents and Carers will be aware, ClassCharts is the online system we use in School to monitor students' behaviour, both positive and negative. Moving forward, we will be utilising additional functions of this system, as such it is essential that all Parents and Carers have full access to ClassCharts. In September, all log in details will be re-shared with Parents and Carers, following this if there are any further issues please get in touch with School and we will be able to support with this. Please note 'ClassCharts Parents' is a free app available on all android and iPhone devices.

Our school community has identified and fully supports that this change will further enhance our climate for learning and provide a much greater opportunity for students to be fully focussed.



5. The School Day

In 2023-24, Wyvern Academy will continue to operate a two-week timetable (Week A and Week B), covering Monday to Friday of each week. All students are expected on site by 0840. Lessons will end at 1445.

6. Free School Meal Allocation

The Local Authority is utilising the new Government Household Support Grant to support families who are entitled to Free School Meals by providing finance for students who are entitled to Free School Meals for the summer holiday period. Each Free School Meal student will receive £72 per FSM pupil for the summer holiday period. The funding is to support families with food and fuel costs. Please note that this only applies to students currently on roll – new Year 7 pupils will receive this funding through their Primary schools.
