Year 11 Leavers Prom - Wednesday 6th July 2022

All students will have professional souvenir photographs taken as these will be produced digitally for our students to download. There will be a mocktail upon arrival, a carvery meal with dessert and disco included. On the evening there is also a Prom King and Queen elected by the year group at the prom and also a few extra surprises. A bar service will be available serving soft drinks only. (This is not covered in the price of the ticket).

The cost of the prom will be £38.00 to be paid in full before **Friday 8th April 2022**.
